Eastdil Secured has been made aware of a recruitment fraud involving scammers posing as hiring managers recruiting via email, text, and social media. The scammers are creating misleading email accounts, conducting remote “interviews,” and making fake job offers in order to collect personal and financial information from unsuspecting individuals. Do not respond to unsolicited business propositions and/or offers of employment from people with whom you are unfamiliar and never disclose your personal or financial details.

Please note that Eastdil Secured only uses company email addresses, which contain “@eastdilsecured.com”, to communicate with candidates via email. If you are contacted by someone about an open job at Eastdil Secured, please verify the domain of the sender’s email address. During the recruiting process, a candidate WILL NOT be asked for any personal information other than contact information to facilitate recruitment; limited to email address and phone number. Candidates will be advised of additional background check details from the Eastdil Secured Recruiter.
